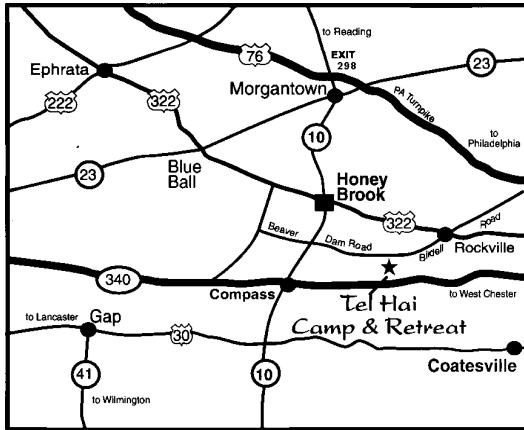


DIRECTIONS

From exit 298 of the PA Turnpike, take Route 10 south to the stoplight at Honey Brook. Continue on Route 10 for about 3 miles to Beaver Dam Road. Turn left onto Beaver Dam Road and continue east for about 1.5 miles. Tel Hai Camp will be on your right.

From Route 30, take Route 10 North about 5 miles to Beaver Dam Rd. After turning right (east) onto Beaver Dam Rd continue about 1.5 miles to the camp entrance.

General Information:

◆ **Sign Up:** These are co-ed classes for Home schoolers. Archery and Canoeing are ages 10 through high school. Maximum class size is 16 for archery and 14 for canoeing.

◆ **Registration:** Deadline is March 31st. Please fill out and send in the enclosed form.

◆ **Fee:** Each course costs **\$47.00** per child for entire course. Fee is due with your registration.

◆ Upon confirmation of registration, you will receive an information letter as well as a health form which you will need to complete, sign and return. One is also available on our website. You will receive more detailed course information on the first day.

◆ **Certificate of Completion:** Upon successful completion of the course, which includes faithful attendance and evidence of growth in skills, participants will receive a certificate of completion.

◆ **All equipment provided:**

- Archery: Students may use their own equipment if desired after it is inspected by the instructor. No bows over 30 lb draws will be allowed.

- Canoeing: Students may use their own life jacket if desired after it is inspected by the instructor.

ARCHERY CLASS

◆ **Class Instruction:** The primary objective for this course is to teach level 1 archery skills, including history, safety, terminology, proper form and techniques, and scoring. Each weekly session will include warm ups, instruction and practice time, as well as evaluation of skills.

◆ **Bruce Gregory, Instructor:** Bruce Gregory, Program Director of Tel Hai Camp & Retreat, has been trained according to NAA instruction. He has been instructing archery since 1983, both teaching campers and training staff.

◆ **Intermediate Class:** This class is for those students who completed the class last year, demonstrated above average skills, and wish to go on to the next level. **Call Bruce for acceptance in this class.**



◆ Two classes of Archery I and Intermediate Archery are being offered this year. Both respective classes are the same in content. Please note on registration form your preference.

- **Archery I** - Tuesdays or Thursdays

- **Inter. Archery** - Tuesdays or Thursdays
2:30 - 4:00 p.m.

CANOEING/KAYAK CLASS

◆ **Class Instruction:** The primary objective of this course is to teach basic to intermediate skills, including safety, terminology, proper canoe and kayak entry and exit, paddle strokes for lake and river canoeing. Each weekly class will include instruction time as well as practice and evaluation of skills.

◆ **Bruce Gregory, Instructor:** Bruce Gregory, Program Director of Tel Hai Camp & Retreat, has Red Cross Training in Canoeing and Lifeguarding. He has been instructing canoeing since 1984, both teaching campers and training staff.

◆ Two class times are being offered this year - Tuesdays or Thursdays 12:30 - 2:00 p.m. Both classes are the same in content.
